## Our First Storyline Projects are taking off!



This week our students and teachers in all grade levels began to work on their first storyline units. Storyline is a project-based, arts integrated teaching approach that we use here at LFCSA to help the curriculum come to life for our students. Each grade level is given a project, to brainstorm, design, build and then present. Here are some examples of this trimester's storyline projects:

- Design an Amusement Park (TK/K/1)
- Build a Travel Agency specializing in trips to California Regions (4th)
- Redesign a Shopping Center to help it serve it's community better (3rd).

As students work together to plan their storyline projects, teachers will present them with problems to solve.

These problem often reflect things that may be happening in the classroom. For example: one of the employees at the Amusement Park will not share his space with another employee. There is not enough room to accommodate all 25 booths What should we do?

They also may reflect things happening in our community, for example: we are in a severe draught and the Mayor of the town where the Shopping Center is being built would like us to make sure we are being considerate of this when designing our Shopping Center. What do you think we need to change?



Our students are excited about their assignments and are already hard at work drawing blueprints, discussing ideas with their groups and building their frieze. They look forward to presenting their work at the end of the trimester. Ask them about their Storyline project, we are sure they will have a lot to share.

As a tuition-free public charter school, LFCSA students and families are given access to a remarkably unique educational program that fosters children's learning in and through the arts.

Without the Annual Give, we would not be able to provide full-time specialists, or as many aides as we do, to name a few things.

We are projecting \$10,050 per pupil in expenditures, with \$10,250 in revenues without fundraising.

That's a deficit of \$200 per student, which indicates that more than \$100,000 is needed to maintain our current budget.

We do solicit funding from other sources, but the Annual Give is our largest fundraiser.

This year, we have set a goal of **\$100,000** in order to be able to maintain our educational program.
