Our teachers and students were excited to meet all their new classmates and spent this first week getting to know each other!

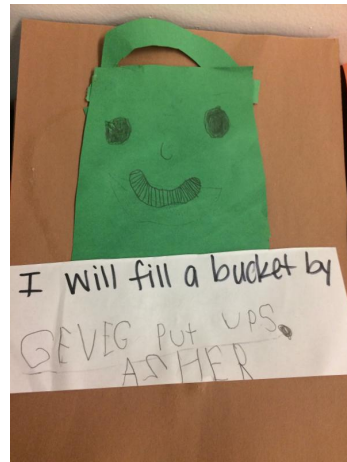
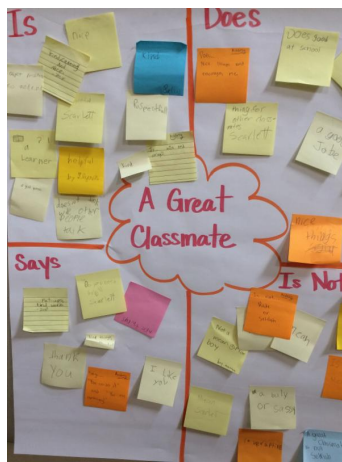
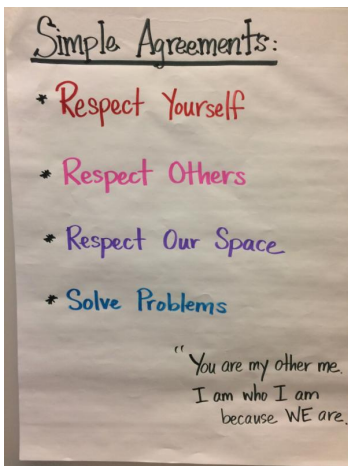


Ms Goldberg's class played an "ice breaker" game to get to know each other.

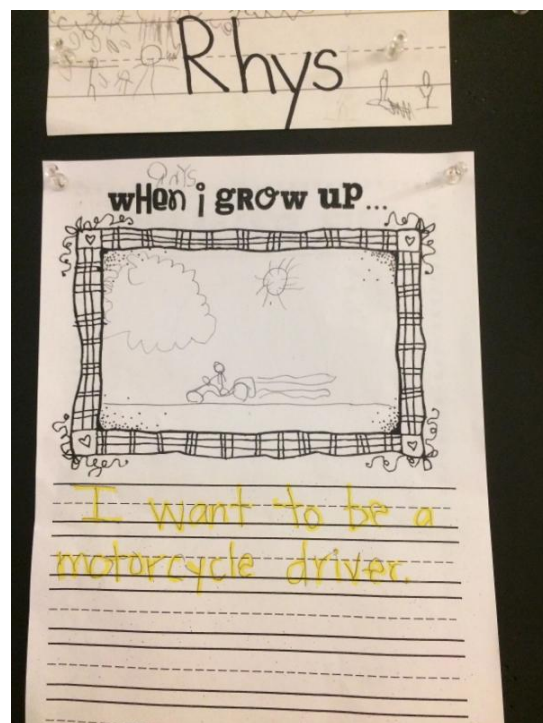
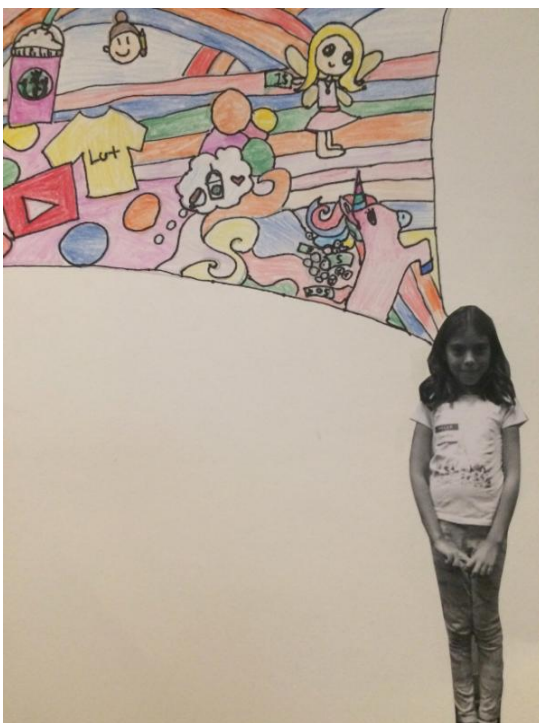
Our new and returning students had a lot of fun creating art and playing games that helped them find out more about their classroom, teacher, school and community.

Information: Pick up, Drop off and Lunch Boxes

Our transition week has come to an end.

Thank you to all our parents for supporting our teachers and saying your goodbyes on the yard. This has helped them all build strong morning routines that will help your child transition from home to school much easier.

Drop off: Starting next week, parents will not be allowed to enter the playground. Please allow 15 minutes to get through the carpool line. This will go a lot faster once all our new families get used to this new morning routine. If you arrive after your child's bell time, please have them walk through the front office. If they need assistance getting there let the carpool aide know they are late and they will help them. A staff member will guide them to their class once inside.

Pick up: Only parents who walk or take public transportation can use the black gate for pick up. All other parents must use the carpool route. Please arrive at your child's pick up time.

If you need to meet with your teacher in the morning please make an appointment before you arrive. The teacher will meet you in the front office at your appointment time.

All parents entering the school must sign in and wear a visitors pass. Please remember to sign out and return your visitors pass when you leave.

Lunch boxes: Please make sure your lunch boxes, snack sacks and water bottles are labeled with: Teacher's name and child's name

If your child has misplaced an item, please check the **Lost and Found** bin located outside. All found items are placed there within 48 hours.

The Board's roles and responsibilities include establishing and approving all major educational and operational policies, approving all major contracts, approving the school's annual budget and overseeing the school's fiscal affairs, and selecting and evaluating the top administrative staff. In conjunction with the top staff, the board has the responsibility of determining what outside legal and consulting services the school requires and contracting for such services.

Each year members attend six full board meetings (every other month) plus one half-day retreat, serve on committees which meet on the off months, contribute to task forces as needed, and engage with outside persons and institutions in an effort to promote outreach and foster collaborations with those who can help further the mission of LFCSA. Members are asked to make a personally meaningful financial contribution to the school.
