Inside our Classrooms: Family Math Nights



Our LFCSA parents and teachers came together this week to solve problems together - math problems! Parents had the opportunity to watch a math lesson in action and even participate themselves by solving math problems the LFCSA way!

It was very informative to hear feedback from our parents on the challenges they face at home, when working with their child. Teachers were able to share strategies parents could use to help their child become confident mathematicians.

Our parents got to participate in a Number Talk, a key feature of our CGI (Cognitively Guided Instruction) math curriculum. Through the Number Talk, parents were able to work on a math problem together and come up with different strategies on how to solve it. They then worked on explaining their strategy and reviewing other parents' strategies to solving the same problem. It was interesting to see how many different ways there was to solve the same problem.

In our TK-2nd grade classes teachers also shared how manipulatives like blocks, crayons, egg cartons and marbles could be used to visualize a math problem. They shared students' counting collections and their math art work.
